Vesna Vega is an artist, activist, and mother working with new media technologies—including Generative Art, Al, Augmented Reality, Video, and Motion Graphic Animation—to explore the intersections of science, art, and spirituality. Her work examines the tensions between nature and technology, the organic and the synthetic, progress and memory. Through this lens, she investigates trauma, healing, and transformation, using art as both a personal sanctuary and a political act.

At the core of her practice is a deep inquiry into the nature of reality—what is real, what is constructed, and how perceptions are shaped by memory, technology, and collective experience. By unveiling hidden narratives and challenging systemic silence, she seeks to create spaces for reflection, resistance, and renewal.

Her work includes interactive spatial installations, video design for theatre and dance, and live AV performances. She works as a video designer, videographer, interdisciplinary artist, and mentor.

Vesna Vega, 1979 (born Krebs), attended the Faculty of Education and graduated as a professor of art pedagogy under the mentorship of Dušan Zidar, focusing on the concept of appropriating images as an artistic concept through the works of Marina Gržinić and Aina Šmid. After completing her studies, she furthered her knowledge in the field of new media and video design.

In 2007, she embarked on a lifelong artistic and personal collaboration with Borut Vega, creating together as the creative tandem *Interference*. Their creative practice explores obsolete and modern technologies, experimental interfaces, information-rich (dis-)ordered states, and chaotic behaviours.

Between 2012 and 2017, she gained experience in London, where she participated in student theatre productions at UAL Central Saint Martins, among other projects. In 2014, she provided video projection for the dance performance "Toy box" at Opéra National de Lorraine. During her time in London, she created several videos for composers and musicians such as Leo Abrahams, Tanja Holt, and Fiona Brice. In late 2014, she staged an interactive video projection for String Quartet nr.4 at the Guildhall School of Music & Drama in London. She also collaborated on the set design and video projection for "Cautionary Tales for Daughters" at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival in 2015. Additionally, she performed with an interdisciplinary performance titled "In Camera" at the Prague Quadrennial of Performance Design and Space (PQ) in 2015.

To date, she has designed videos for over 25 domestic and international productions, continuously pushing boundaries and introducing new technologies into theatre. Since 2011, she has been part of the artistic team of director Ivana Djilas and has collaborated with other directors such as Tin Grabnar, Nina Šorak, Janez Pipan, and Primož Ekart.

Since 2019, she has designed numerous STEMA workshops for children, serving as a mentor to introduce contemporary art through computer technologies to younger audiences, thereby promoting creative thinking and creation using modern technologies. She is also a co-founder of the DadaDisko project, which organises dance events and workshops encouraging active engagement between children and parents through various forms of digital art.

She has received several awards at international and domestic festivals, including the Special Award for Overall Visual Design for the performance "Obisk" at the 24th International Puppet Festival Zlata iskra in Serbia in 2022, and the Grand Prize for Set Design for the performance "Čriček in temačni občutek" at the Serbian Biennial of Stage Design in 2022.

She is a mother of two girls.
